

INFORMATION NOTE CONCERNING TOLLS
APPLIED TO LIGHT VEHICLES

(Classes 1, 2 and 5)

Besides "one way" tolls, as provided for throughout the motorway system, at the Mont Blanc Tunnel forms of toll have been set up to satisfy the requirements of the border population.

For vehicles in classes 1, 2 and 5 (tourist traffic), the following forms of transaction are in force:

◆ *Return ticket*

If you return by midnight of the seventh day after the day of issue, a discount is given, when you return, of 75 %.

The cost of two one-way journeys is thus brought down by 38 %.

◆ *10 transit subscription card valid for 2 years*

This is a prepaid subscription valid for 10 journeys that must take place by the end of the twenty-fourth month, not counting the month of purchase.

The toll is calculated allowing a discount of 50% on the cost of 5 return tickets

◆ *20 transit subscription card valid for 2 years*

This is a prepaid subscription valid for 20 journeys that must take place by the end of the twenty-fourth month, not counting the month of purchase.

The toll is calculated allowing a discount of 65% on the cost of 10 return tickets.

For vehicles in classes 1 and 5 (cars and motorcycles), the "ChamCourma" is also available:

◆ *The "ChamCourma" set price for 50 crossings which is valid for 1 month*

This is a season ticket for a named individual valid for 50 crossings to be made in a period of 30 consecutive days in addition to the day of its activation (one outward and one return journey a day).

The fare is calculated based on an 84% discount on the cost of 25 round trips.

Payment may be made both in cash and with the credit cards of either banks (VISA, MASTERCARD, EUROCARD e AMERICAN EXPRESS) or service companies (DKV, ESSO, EUROTRAFIC / GR, EUROSHELL, UTA, ROUTEX, and RESSA).
